For the Applicant:

1. Complete the first page sections 1, 2 and 3.
2. Sign Section 4: Applicant Declaration.
3. Save a copy of the completed form for your records.
4. Provide a copy of the completed form and any other documentation to support your application to the LALC for consideration at a LALC Members' Meeting.
5. Section 54 of the ALRA says that a person seeking to be accepted as a voting member of a LALC, can attach a notice from the Registrar declaring that the person is not a voting member of any other LALC. By completing the 54 (3)(c) form and receiving a notice from ORALRA, you can attach this to your membership application when submitting it to your chosen LALC. This ensures that if you wish to become a voting member and your application is accepted by the members, you can be added to the membership roll as a voting member without delay.

For People Joining a Second LALC:

If you are a voting member of one LALC and wish to join and become a voting member of another LALC, you must first be accepted as a non-voting member of the second LALC. You must then make a nomination under section 56 to change the Council in which you want to have voting rights. You can only be a residential member at one LALC at a time. Additional memberships must be based on association or as a registered Aboriginal Owner. For membership based on residence, your residential address must be within the LALC boundaries.

If you are a registered Aboriginal Owner for land that is within the LALC boundary, your LALC Membership application does not need to be accepted at a members meeting.

Previous Members:

If you were a previous member of a LALC, you can rejoin that LALC by providing a previous membership form to the LALC. This may be dependent on the reason for prior removal from the roll.

For the LALC CEO:

1. Ensure the form has the required information to enable your members to decide applications based on residence or association at the next members meeting.
2. Complete section 5 of this form after the meeting.
3. Please scan each application as an individual file.
4. Provide completed membership application forms to membership@oralra.nsw.gov.au.
5. Where applications have not been accepted, there is no need to provide the Registrar this form.
6. Note that registered Aboriginal Owner LALC Membership applications do not need to be accepted by the members.

For Information:

ORALRA requires this information to maintain the consolidated membership roll.

Section 54 of the ALRA says a person seeking to be accepted as a member of a LALC must submit to that LALC a written application for membership. This form ensures all essential requirements are met for an accepted member to be entered onto the LALC membership roll.
